



E-Recycling

Has Moved to Hutto

As of November 2009, Waste Management's Austin Community Landfill will no longer accept **obsolete electronics** at the landfill. Instead, residents are asked to bring their electronics, computers, cell phones, printers and other E-recyclables to the Hutto Recycling Center located at the Williamson County Landfill on 101 Landfill Road. Waste Management's Hutto recycling facility was created in 2005 and is ideally set up to accept and process all levels of recyclables and e-waste.

Since opening its doors, the Recycling Center has kept over 680 tons of recyclable material from becoming part of the county's landfill. And, as of October 2009, the number of monthly visitors has also increased from just 65 in the first month of operation to a steady stream of 400-500 visitors each month.

Directions from the Austin City Landfill:

1. Head southwest on Giles Lane toward US-290 W (0.2 mi)
2. Turn left at US-290 E (1.9 mi)
3. Merge onto TX-130 N via the ramp on the left to TX-45 N (17.2 mi)
4. Take the exit toward E Chandler St (0.6 mi)
5. Keep right at the fork to continue toward E Chandler St (0.3 mi)
6. Turn right at E Chandler St (3.4 mi)
7. Turn left at Farm to Market Rd 1660 (0.7 mi)
8. Take the 1st left onto Co Rd 128/Landfill Rd
